

The Introduction and the History of Yanwan Elementary School in Taitung County:

1. Brief School History

This school was newly established in September, the 46th year of the Republic of China. It attached to Beinan Common School and named as Yanwan Branch. It renamed as Yanwan Common School independently in September, the 49th year of the Republic of China. Due to implementing nine-years national education, it renamed as Yanwan Elementary School in the 57th year of the Republic of China. It received commands from county government to set up the subsidiary kindergarten in April, the 74th year of the Republic of China. It received orders again to subsume kindergarten formally to school organization in the 101st year of the Republic of China.

2. School Geography and Environment

The school address is “No.11, Aly. 401, Ln. 50, Yanwan Rd., Taitung City, Taitung County 950, Taiwan (R.O.C).” It’s near Taitung Train Station, Beinan Cultral Park, Liji Badlands, and Beinan Dazun Water Conservation Park. The environment is beautiful and classy. There are many outdoor and environmental education resouces.

3. Faculty and Staff Overview

There are a total of 26 faculty and staff, including a principle, 2 directors, 2 section chiefs, 6 homeroom teachers, 1 subject teacher, 1 English itinerant teacher, 5 native language support teachers, 3 staff members, 1 military service substitute, 2 kindergarten teachers, 1 educare giver, and 1 kitchen worker. The incumbent principal is Ms. LI,LI-HUANG.

4. Students Overview

There are 6 classes for elementary school and 1 class for kindergarten. There are 52 elementary school students and 26 kindergarten students. The total number of classes is 7, and the total number of students is 78. Most of students are Minnan and Hakka people, accounting for about 52%, followed by the indigenous students, accounting for about 48%. The number of students in the school is small, but the students are pure and kind, optimistic and lively.

5. School Vision and Characteristics

School education vision is Health, Care, and Enterprise. Expecting students to become the world's citizens with physical and mental health, and good character. School characteristics are environmental education, character education, reading education, students’ inline skating club, and recorder club.
